

## MITROPA RALLY CUP 2020

### Bulletin No. 1/2020

For the general regulations of the Mitropa Rally Cup 2020  
DMSB Visa No. 605/20, approved on 05.12.2019

From now on the following changes and additions are valid  
(Changes/Additions are printed in *italics*)

#### Art. 7 Events

**Art. 7.1 Calendar of events** is changed as follows:

#### 8. Classification

**8.1 Scale of points** is changed as follows:

In order to get ranked, the driver/co-driver must have taken part in at least 3 rallies.

#### **Bonus points for a start in a foreign country (based on the nationality in their passport):**

- For participants from (east) CZE, SVK, POL and RUS, events taking place in Slovenia are not considered as a start in a foreign country.
- For participants from (north) NLD, BEL, LUX, DNK, SWE, FIN, CHE and LIE, events taking place in Austria are not considered as a start in a foreign country.
- For drivers from (south) FRA, ESP, MCO and SMR, ***rally Opatija and Mecsek rally*** are not considered as a start in a foreign country.
- For participants from GER, ***rally Velenje and rally Citta di Bassano*** are not considered as a start in a foreign country.
- ***For participants from HUN, rally Opatija (HRV) is not considered as a start in a foreign country.***
- For participants from HRV, ***rally Mecsek (HUN) is not considered as a start in a foreign country.***
- ***For participants from ITA, rally Citta di Bassano is considered as a start in a foreign country.***

These rules are also the base for reduced entry fee in foreign countries according to Art. 4.2.

In cases, in which a subsequent correction needs to be carried out by the series organiser after the publication of the championship and/or series classification due to an obvious error or mistake, this can be done by the series organiser. Complaints regarding the series classification shall be addressed to the series organiser. No appeal against the decision of the series organiser will be accepted.”
