



# 55<sup>th</sup> Mitropa Rally Cup 2019 Regulations



## Organisation (GR, Art. 2)

The community of interests (CI) Mitropa Cup, composed by the President, the Vice-President, the Secretariat and the event promoters, organises the 55<sup>th</sup> Mitropa Rally Cup 2019. The following summary is an excerpt from the FIA-approved General Regulations (GR): DMSB-Visa-No.: /19

## Entries (GR, Art. 4 and 8)

Drivers and co-drivers from all European countries.

- For participants from (east) CZE, TUR, SVK, POL and RUS, events taking place in Slovenia are not considered as a start in a foreign country.
- For participants from (north) NLD, BEL, LUX, DNK, SWE, FIN, CHE and LIE, events taking place in Austria are not considered as a start in a foreign country.
- For Drivers from (south) FRA, ESP, MCO and SMR, events taking place in Italy are not considered as a start in a foreign country.
- For participants from DEU, events in HRV are not considered as a start in a foreign country.
- For participants from HUN, events in DEU are not considered as a start in a foreign country.
- For participants from HRV, events in HUN are not considered as a start in a foreign country.

For scoring points and to benefit from "Mitropa Rally Cup Plus" all drivers and co-drivers take the nationality of their passport.

## Eligible Vehicles (GR, tech. reg. Art. 1)

### Mitropa Rally Cup

All cars according to Art. 4 - Eligible Cars of 2019 FIA Regional Rally Championships Sporting Regulations. All cars must comply with the 2019 FIA regulations and any provisions of the respective ASN.

### Mitropa Rally Historic Cup

Historic vehicles in compliance with the FIA Appendix K regulations. All historic vehicles must be in possession of a valid Historic Technical Passport (HTP).

In the case of a tie after the last event, the higher position resulting from the overall classification of the last event will be taken into consideration.

5 bonus points for each start, 5 additional bonus points if classified in an event.

In the case of a tie after the last event, the higher points resulting from the overall classification of the last calendar-event (if applicable the next to last, and so on) will be taken into consideration.

### Number of rallies for the Cup classification:

If 7 or more rallies are organised: 6 results  
If 6 rallies are organised: 5 results  
Less than 6 rallies are organised: all results.  
For Challenge Light Trophy (max 5 rallies) all results will count.

In order to be classified, the driver/co-driver must have taken part in 3 rallies at least.

## Classifications (GR, Art. 16)

### Mitropa Rally Cup (FIA App. J)

#### - Driver

The participant with the highest number of points in the driver classification will receive the Mitropa Rally Cup.

Prize money: 1. place - 2.000 Euro  
2. place - 1.000 Euro  
3. place - 750 Euro

- **Co-Driver**

The participant with the highest score in the co-driver classification will receive the Mitropa Rally Co-Driver Cup.

**Mitropa Rallye Historic Cup (FIA App. K)**

- **Driver**

The participant with the highest number of points in the driver classification will receive the Mitropa Rally Historic Cup.

Prize money: 1. place - 1.500 Euro  
2. place –1.000 Euro  
3. place - 500 Euro

- **Co-Driver**

The participant with the highest score in the co-driver classification will receive the Mitropa Rallye Historic Co-Driver Cup.

**Prize Giving Ceremony**

The Mitropa Rally Cup prize giving ceremony 2019 will take place in Bassano (ITA) on 23. November.

All registered participants will receive an invitation for the prize giving ceremony. This invitation includes the participation in the gala dinner, valid for two persons. Price money and cups will not be sent on to the teams.

**General**

- Two "Mitropa Rally Cup" stickers (approx. 25 x 21 cm) **must** be placed in full view on both sides of the rally car during all the qualifying events

- **Mitropa Rally Cup Plus**

for registered participants in the drivers' classification for starts in foreign countries (see also "**Entries**"): Free entry fee, inclusive of 1 service package.

**Please note:** An administration fee of 150,- Euro (up to 130 SS-km) or 200,- Euro (more than 130 SS-km) may be charged by the organisers.

- Special awards will be issued by the organiser during prize giving of each event to the three best placed Mitropa Rally Cup and historic participants.

# Mitropa Rally Club Championship 2019

## Organisation (GR, Art. 2)

The community of interests (IG) Mitropa Cup, consisting of the president, vice president and the secretariat, organizes together with the organizers the Mitropa Rally Club Championship 2019.

## Eligible vehicles (GR, tech. reg. Art. 1)

**Youngtimers (vehicles with expired homologation) - must comply with the regulations of the respective ASN organizing the event. There is no entitlement to a starting place at the individual events due to registration in the Mitropa Rally Club Championship.**

10 bonus points for each start in a foreign (except of Challenge light trophy) – the maximum of 50 bonus points will be taken into consideration.

In the case of a tie after the last event, the higher points resulting from the overall classification of the last calendar-event (if applicable the next to last, and so on) will be taken into consideration.

If there is a tie of points after the last event, the better ranking at the last event will be decisive.

## Number of rallies for the Cup classification:

If 7 or more rallies are organised:	6 results
If 6 rallies are organised:	5 results
Less than 6 rallies are organised:	all results.

For Challenge Light Trophy (max 5 rallies) all results will count.

In order to be classified, the driver/co-driver must have taken part in 3 rallies at least.

## Classifications (GR, Art. 16)

- **Youngtimer**  
The participant with the highest number of points in the driver classification with a vehicle that is not eligible to start in the FIA or FIA historic classes or groups.  
Prize-money: 1. place - 2.000 Euro  
2. place - 1.000 Euro  
3. place - 750 Euro
- **Challenge**  
The participant with the highest number of points in the Mitropa Rally Cup or in the Mitropa Rally Club Championship with a two-wheel drive vehicle will receive the Mitropa Rally Challenge Cup.  
Prize-money: 1. place - 1.500 Euro  
2. place - 1.000 Euro  
3. place - 500 Euro
- **Challenge Light Trophy (CLT)**  
The participant with the highest number of points in the Mitropa Rally Cup or in the Mitropa Rally Club Championship with a vehicle from the RC4 group (without R2 vehicles), RC5 or with an expired homologation of equal performance (on application to the IG Mitropa Cup) will receive the Mitropa Rally Challenge Light Trophy.  
Prize-money: 1. place - 1.000 Euro  
2. place - 750 Euro  
3. place - 500 Euro
- **Newcomer**  
The participant in the Mitropa Rally Cup or in the Mitropa Rally Club Championship with the highest score in the driver classification and not older than 25 years (born 1994 or later) will receive the Mitropa Rally Newcomer Cup.  
Prize-money: 1. place: 500 Euro
- **Ladies Cup**  
The female team with the highest number of points in the Mitropa Rally Cup or in the Mitropa Rally Club Championship receives the Mitropa Rally Ladies Cup.
- **Nations Cup**  
The nation with the highest sum of points from his three best participants in the modern FIA driver ranking will receive the Mitropa Rally Nations Cup.
- **Historic Trophy**  
The participant with the highest number of points in the Historic Drivers' Championship with a two-wheel drive vehicle up to 2000cc without recharging will receive the Mitropa Rally Historic Trophy.
